Please read these Reminders

- For those of you that do not have the upper wire dividers, please be aware that the ledge between booths is a "SHARED SPACE" for both booths. Please be considerate and leave space for your neighbor
- EVERYTHING in your booth needs to have a tag! If an item is not for sale, it still needs to be tagged with your vendor number and NOT FOR SALE. No TAG, No SALE! Remember; tags= your money!!
- AND a big reminder about tags, your vendor number on the top, brief description of the item in the
 center, and price on the bottom. Hang tags only, no sticky tags, please. It is OK to tape hang-tags on
 wood or glassware or to pin your tags on fabric items
- Rent is due on the 1st of the month, payable up to the 10th and late with a \$10 late fee after that date
- A thirty-day written notice is required when you are shrinking down or vacating your booth at the end of the month. The notice MUST be to us on or before the first day of the month you want to vacate. For instance, if you want to vacate at the end of April, we must have the notice no later than April 1!!
- Ask about the "Finder's Fee" booth rent credit!!!

Many vendors have been changing out stock and refreshing their booths. It is a great time to get those booths fresh, cleaned up and ready to sell, sell sell!!!! Think Spring Cleaning!!

Please remember to stay within the boundaries of your booth(s). It is very important that you do not have things sticking out from your booth into the aisles. The store must remain in compliance with fire code, and we never know when the fire marshal or code enforcement will come in for a walk through.

There are several booths that have so much stuff on the floor that it is difficult to walk into them. Customers will not ask for help to get things out of an overcrowded booth. Please try to keep a safe walk area in your booths.

If you use the vacuum PLEASE, PLEASE empty the debris cup, check the hose for clogs and CLEAN the filter in the top. Ask the staff for help if you need to.
